

Lions Face Net Raiders Tomorrow

The State tennis team, winner of its last four starts, went through light drills yesterday in preparation for the always-tough Colgate contingent who will be here at 1:30 p.m. tomorrow on the varsity courts for the Lions' next-to-last home match.

Coach Sherm Fogg's outfit worked out yesterday on the community courts, because the varsity courts on campus were still unplayable. The Colgate meet will be held on the varsity courts tomorrow, weather permitting.

The Raiders will be out to spoil a couple of State seasonal marks. The Lions currently own a four-game win streak and an undefeated skein of two on home courts. Colgate handed the Foggmen one of their three setbacks, 8-1, at Hamilton, N.Y., earlier in the season.

Colgate will probably go with the same crew that handled the earlier shellacking. Fogg's doubles team of Dick Gross and Gus Bigott took the only State win in the match in the number three position to avert the shutout. Gross-Bigott defeated Strickler-Soderland in two sets, 6-3, 6-3.

The Raider singles lineup will probably include Bishop, Stern, Herman, Cleaver, McCormick, and Zarbaugh. Bishop-Stern, Troup-Cleaver, and Strickler-Soderland will probably go in the doubles outfits.

Fogg said that he will announce both his singles and doubles choices for the Colgate match after practice today.

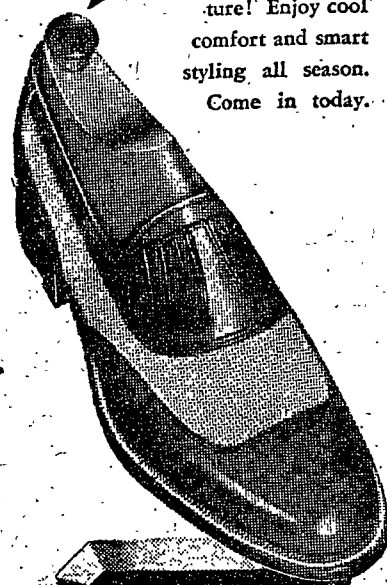
