High of 24 Go Delta Sigma Phi; Phi Kappa Tau Is 2d With 23

Of the 577 men pledged this year by the 49 fraternities listed in the Student Union register, Delta Sigma Phi took the highest number with 24 men pledged and Phi Kappa Tau was second with 23.
