 directed postwar agricultural re-habilitation there, taught western agricultural practices at Lingnan College and provided the West with many Oriental foods and plants.

Brehm Cited

McCroxy was lauded for his role in the development of his adopted country, Canada. His work in hydroelectric expansion was noted as were his contributions to mankind. Nick was recognized not only for his service to many businesses and industries but also for his contributions of time and money to charitable work and to civic undertakings.

The citation was directed to Brehm as a "teacher, researcher, and citizen." The medallions and scrolls were presented by President Eisenhower with Eric A. Walker, dean of the School of Engineering, and Lyman E. Jackson, dean of the School of Agriculture, reading the citations.

Eisenhower in his talk said that the nation is based on its rank and file but that it recognizes those with unusual aptitude. The national belief, he said, is in the perfectibility of mankind and prestige and property are used as a stimulant.

He said that there is a need for leadership in the realm of ideas and to help convert an understanding of these ideas into everyday workings. Men and women with the qualities of leadership and scholarship as were being honored last night, gave him confidence in tomorrow, he said.
