end to the public opinion of collegiate drinking. The percentage of students drinking more than once a week is probably quite a bit higher than the report indicates. It is also hard to be-lieve only 43 per cent of men students drink no more than once a month.

A survey of 16,000 students and 27 colleges is an admir-able task, and the results may be the closest we have to the true picture of college drinking. But college drinking varies with the type and size of school, the average student income, and the age of the student. Surely, only 27 colleges cannot pre-sent a true picture, although they may present a fair one.
