

Hort Show To Be Given For Alumni

The 41st Annual Hort Show, a feature of Homecoming Weekend, will be held from 10 a.m. to 9 p.m. today and from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. tomorrow in the Stock Judging Pavilion.

The theme, "Today's Garden Design," will show contemporary gardening for today's architecture in landscaping around the front of a modern home. The 22-foot ranch type home, completed with a breezeway was built by members of the Horticulture Club in one day.

A stone base with vertical panels of wood was used to construct the house.

The landscaping will feature flagstone walks, over 1400 square feet of grass and turf, and a modernistic pool, Howard Angstadt, show manager, said.

The entrance to the pavilion will be flanked on one side by a fruit display, and on the other by a vegetable garden with plant breeders' latest displays arranged in the garden.

Chrysanthemums and roses will be on display at the far end with circular flower gardens surrounding a willow tree and garden statuary.

Visitors may buy apples and cider at the sales booth.

More than thirty students are working on the show which annually attracts over 10,000 visitors.

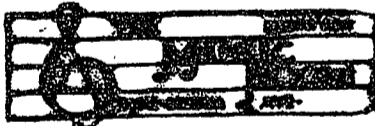
