

Penn State's Lenny Moore strengthened his bid for an all-American berth this week by moving into third place in rushing offense, according to figures released by the National Collegiate Athletic Bureau.

By virtue of his 131 yard out-burst against West Virginia Sat-urday, Moore jumped four not-ches over the seventh place he held last week.

The Nittany Lion flash has gained 479 yards this year and lost 14 for his net total of 465, averaging 7.1 yards per carry. He leads the Lions in both rushing and total offense offense.

Moore is also number 19 across the nation in total offense. He ranks behind Arizona's lke

Luppino and Colorado's Bob Bay uk in the rushing department. Luppino has garnered 607 yards, 142 more than the Nittany gridder, in the same number of games four. He has carried the ball 66 times, as compared to 65 for


