Kitty Campbell, women's editor of the Philadelphia Evening Bulletin, will be guest speaker at the annual tea sponsored by Theta Sigma Phi, national women's professional journal, in fraternity, at 2 p.m. Sunday in Atherton Hall.

Miss Campbell specializes in women's dress fashions and recently attended the Parish fashion show of designer Christian Dior. A picture in which she is shown interviewing Dior appears in the October issue of Life Magazine.

Before transferring to the Bulletin, Miss Campbell was fashion editor of the Philadelphia Inquirer, where she used the pen name of Cynthia Cabot. The name, however, is copyrighted and has remained with the Inquirer.

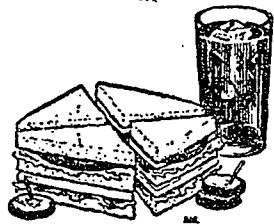
Miss Campbell is a former University student and State College resident. Before turning to column writing, she wrote radio script.

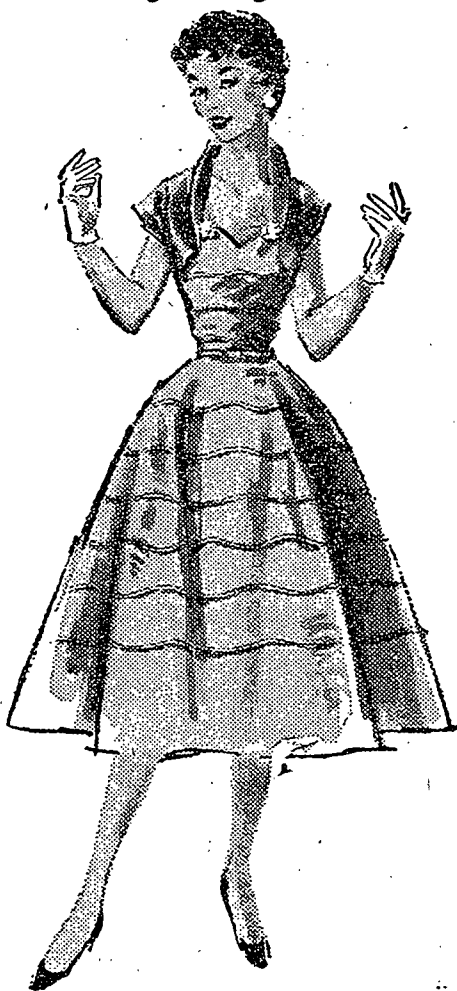

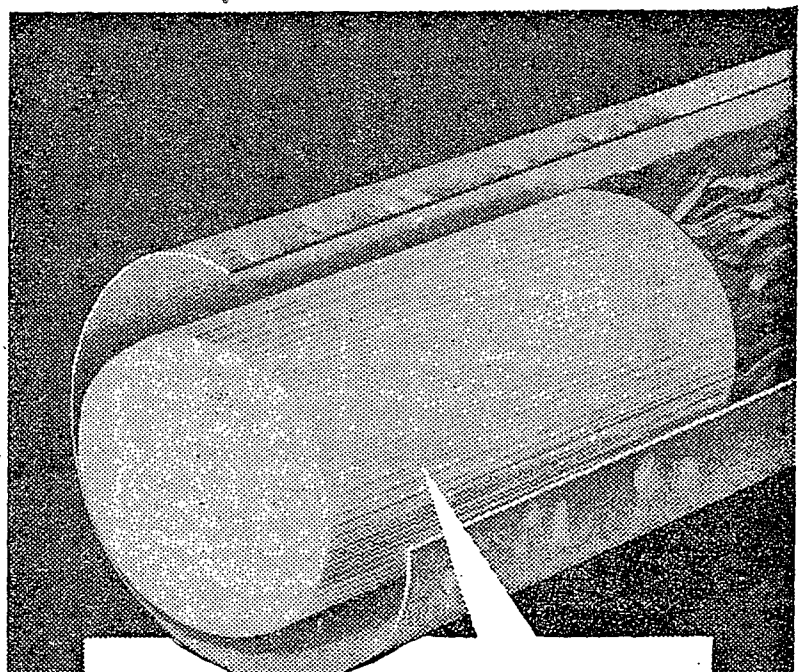
