President Milton S. Eisenhower will leave for Washington Monday to attend the annual meeting of the Association of Land Grant Colleges and Universities which will be held on Tuesday and Wednesday.

Monday evening he will attend a dinner for presidents of member institutions. He will be accompanied to Washington by Lawrence Dennis, administrative assistant to the president, and other faculty and administrative members.

Yesterday Dr. Eisenhower joined his brother, President Dwight D. Eisenhower, on a duck-hunting expedition on Lake Erie. They were accompanied by George Humphrey, Secretary of the Treasury, for the one-day "breather."

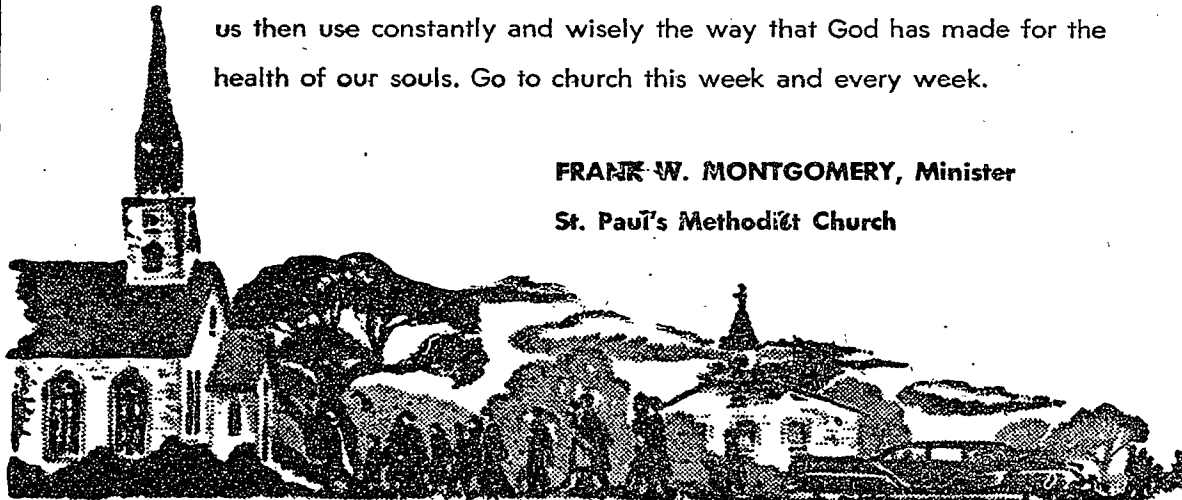
