Brubeck, who has been described by critics as probably the most exciting new jazz artist at work today, has emerged in only a few years from an unknown to one of the top names in jazzdom. In only five years, Brubeck fans have grown from a small, West Coast clique to a coast-to-coast Coast clique to a coast-to-coast crowd — particularly on college campuses. Last June Brubeck made his first Columbia record, "Jazz Goes to College," which for four months outsold any single album by Liberace.
