## Schleman **Addresses** Convocation

The developing and using to the fullest extent of our abilities for a warm understanding and support of our fellow human beings is the essence of the role of the educated woman today, Helen B. Schleman, dean of women at Purdue University, said at the Women's Student Government As-

women's Student Government Association Convocation last night. Speaking on the topic "The Role of the Educated Woman in Society," Miss Schleman said that woman's role today is very controversial. She divided that role into four possible categorieshomemaker, wage earner, volun-teer citizen, and that of a person. In speaking of the traditional

role of the woman as a home-maker, Miss Schleman described the growing feeling of sharing be-tween the man and wife and the modern concept of woman's right to share the man's duties and man's taking part in the woman's work. She emphasized the importance of developing this feeling of sharing, and criticized woman for traditionally assuming the role of man's subordinate.

"The role of homemaker has always been important and responsible, but it is becoming more rewarding because men are becoming homemakers, too," Miss

Schleman said. In discussing woman as a wage earner, Miss Schleman said that too many women in college today are expecting to work for a very short period after graduation and then get married and leave the labor force. She said that statistics show that 52 per cent of the married women in the United States are in the labor force. She also pointed out that an estimated 10 per cent will not get married, and approximately one-third of all women over 14 years old are either widowed, divorced, or sin-


