Students to Play Major Part
 Students themselves will play a major role in accomplishing the third goal—creating an attitude which would hold the student who cheats in disrepute. Howell pointed out that most students who cheat do so because they feel most of the other students in the class are cheating and they will be at a disadvantage if they remain honest.

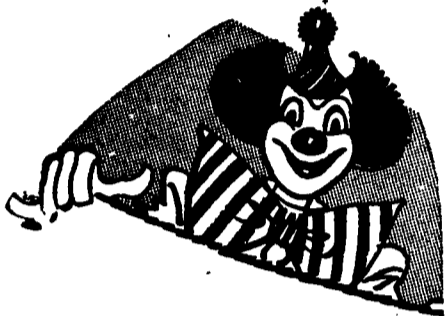
