The FMA board met Monday night but lack of a quorum delayed the decision from being official until yesterday, when one concurring vote from an absentee member was received.

Harold W. Perkins, assistant dean of men, cited the problem of vendors who give 5 per cent discounts to non-FMA members and 6 per cent to FMA. After the 1½ per cent service charge is subtracted Perkins said, the nonmembers receive a larger discount than FMA members.

FMA acts as a buying agent for member fraternities, securing discounts on canned goods and meat through mass buying.

Perkins also told the meeting that FMA must have 40 members before it can realize its goal for greater savings to fraternities. With 40 members, he said, a parttime manager could be employed to run FMA. Thus better service could be obtained.
