MOSCOW, Feb. 24 (A) - The 20th Congress of the Communist party today unanimously warned against any attempt to restore one-man rule in the Soviet Union.

Party boss N. S. Khrushchev and all other top leaders have told the Congress they are devoted to the principle of col-lective rule. They have disavowed any intention to return to the one-man system.
