 the approval of both the president's office and the office of the dean of men, is not designed to appease anyone, Bullock said. Only the University and IFC are protected by the code. The individual fraternity will face the punishment if found violating the ordinance, Bullock said.  
 The proposed code has been pending for a year. Bullock reminded the assembly he had promised to set up a pre-initiation code during his campaign for the IFC presidency last year. However, perennial work seemed to occupy more time than was anticipated, and a lack of persons willing to work on the committee delayed the final drafting of the code, he said.

It is unfortunate that the Hell Week incident at The Massachusetts Institute of Technology happened at this time, because it detracts from the mature intellectual reasoning of the persons who handled the preparation of the code, Bullock said.  
 "Neither the administration nor IFC is attempting to interfere with fraternity objectives," Bullock said. "The object of the code is to form a working basis to curb unnecessary pre-initiation practices which are harming fraternity public relations."

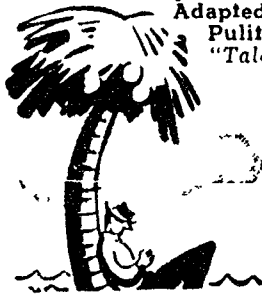
