If weight could be substituted for experience then football Coach Rip Engle would be "loaded" at the tackle position. For when one views the team roster, namely the tackle candidates, the six-footers and 200-pounders are clearly dominant.

Of the seven aspirants for this position only one-Jack Calderone-is under six foot and weighs less than 212 pounds. The senior letterman is a "small" 5-11, 210 pounds and is also the top tackle on Engle's

squad.

The center slot, ably manned by Dan Radakovich and Steve Garban, boasis good although not exceptional weight. Radakovich stands 6-2 and weighs 195, while Garban is 6-0 and weighs 200.

Opening day starters will probably be Calderone and Mazur. Calderone, a fine offensive blocker, will man the right tackle slot, while Mazur is a good bet to be at left tackle, especially on defense.
