Applications are now available for the Amelia Earhart Scholarship for women, offered annually by Zonta International, as organization of executive women.

The scholarship is offered to encourage graduate study by women in the field of aeronautical engineering.

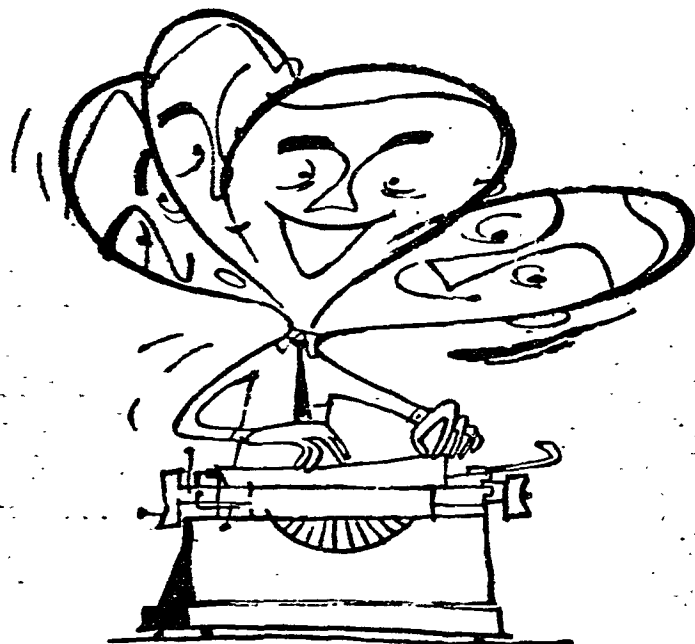

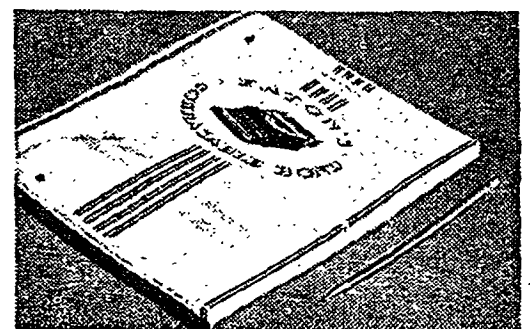
