Bill Introduced In Legislature For Fish Costs

A bill was put in position for House committee consideration yesterday that would appropriate \$50,000 to the state Fish Commission to help pay for the loss of trout killed in Centre County waters.

The Senate introduced a bill Monday that would appropriate \$43,891 to the commission.

The fish were killed Nov. 30 when lethal waste matter was dumped into a stream by the Navy Ordnance Research Laboratory. The University took responsibility for the pollution.

Some question had been raised as to who would be required to pay for the lost fish. The University, being a state-operated school, would have to receive the money from the General Assembly if it were told to carry the burden.

Several weeks ago the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service donated 93,000 trout to the commission to help offset the cost of the kill. The commission estimated the federally-donated fish were worth \$30,500.

In order to run for election, a candidate must secure a petition signed by 20 town independent men. Petition forms may be secured at the Hetzel Union desk.

Final Voting Date
The new constitution will be voted on for the final time at the last TIM meeting of the semester. All members of the organization will have voting privilege for the meeting.

A two-thirds vote will be required for the new constitution to be retained. If the favorable vote is not received, the constitution in effect before its revision will again go into effect.

Next year's TIM council will consist of 26 members nominated by petition and elected in the fall, and the four officers elected this spring.

AIM Representatives
The representatives at large to the AIM Board of Governors will be the men receiving the highest number of votes during the election of the TIM council.

Members of the council will hold office for one year, or until their successors are elected.

In other business, it was announced that a dance for Town Independent Men will be held March 22.
