

Pirates, Behind Friend, Stop KC, 4-3 Sigma Chi Leads 'B' Bowlers

FORT MYERS, Fla., April 4 (AP)—Relying exclusively on singles, the Pittsburgh Pirates today rammed across four runs in the first two innings and hung on for a 4-3 exhibition victory over the Kansas City Athletics.

Bobby Friend, ace Pirate right-hander, gave up all the Athletics' runs in his seven innings on the mound.

The Pirates pushed across a run on successive singles by Bill Viridon, Bob Skinner and Gene Freese in the first. In the second they used five singles to score their remaining runs.

The Athletics scored a run in the third on singles by Hector Lopez, Virgil Trucks and Billy Hunter to end at 31 the number of innings of scoreless ball that Pirate pitchers had hurled against them.

ST. PETERSBURG, Fla., April 4 (AP)—Gil McDougald starred today when the New York Yankees blanked the Philadelphia Phillies, 1-0. The shortstop made a great, lunging catch of a liner to save the game in the top of the ninth and then drove in the winning run with a sacrifice fly after Woody Held opened the Bombers' final at bat with a triple.

Robin Roberts held the Yanks to one hit, a bunt single by Hank Bauer, in eight innings.

SAN ANTONIO, Tex., April 4 (AP)—Duke Snider and Gino Cimoli led Brooklyn to a 14-8 victory over the Milwaukee Braves before 8670 fans at Missions Stadium today.

Snider hit two towering home runs over the 40-foot-high scoreboard 350 feet out in right field, while Cimoli paced the Dodgers'

14-hit attack with three hits. Gino had a home run and two ground rule doubles into the overflow crowd which lined the outfield fences.

John Podres surrendered three runs in five innings, and Rene Valdes was touched for the other five Milwaukee counters in the final two of his four-inning stint.

FT. GORDON, Ga., April 4 (AP)—The Cincinnati Reds, held hitless for six innings by Bob Chalkales, came from behind to defeat the Washington Senators, 5-4, here today in 10 innings.

SALT LAKE CITY, April 4 (AP)—Vic Wertz clubbed two home runs off Allan Worthington of the New York Giants, but the Cleveland Indians made four errors, donated three unearned runs and lost 9-6 today before 5848 fans.


