## E. Germany Felt Inreat to

BONN, Germany, May 3 (AP)-NATO leaders warned today that a turbulent volcano in Eastern Germany threatens peace if the people there are kept in Soviet servitude.

U.S. Secretary of State John Foster Dulles and West German Foreign Minister Heinrich von Brentano led members of the North Atlantic Treaty Council in strongly appealing to Russia to release the East Germans into a free and reunified Germany.

The NATO ministers warned the restless population of East Germany against any "impru-dence" which could only increase their sufferings, and might touch off global conflict if they attempted a Budanest-type revolt. Disarmament Plea Expected
