

# Registration Will Begin Wednesday

Fall registration for more than 13,500 students will begin at 8 a. m. Wednesday at Recreation Hall.

The regular registration period will end at 5 p.m. Friday. Regular students registering after that will be assessed a \$10 fee.

Registration will be in alphabetical order, beginning with persons whose last names begin with the letters Lan to Lea. The alphabetical order rotates each semester to give a different group of persons the advantage of early registration.

**Register Alphabetically**  
Graduates and undergraduates must register alphabetically regardless of class standing. Special students and University employes will register Saturday morning, when late students will register.

Fees must be paid at the burser's office in the basement of Willard Hall before a student may register. The burser's receipt must be presented at the time of registration.

To speed up the registration process, C. O. Williams, dean of admissions, has asked students to see their advisers at least 24 hours before they are scheduled to register.

**Heed Schedule OK**  
The student's schedule must be approved by his faculty adviser and his number 2 registration card, listing the schedule, must be signed by the adviser.

A "timetable," listing available courses, when they are offered and by whom taught, may be bought for 25 cents in the basement of Willard Hall. The timetable also lists on its cover the alphabetical order of registration.

Mall for approximately 600 feet west to the south end of the Mechanical Engineering Building. The structure will drop to a two-story level on the east end. The two-story wing will be connected to the proposed 100-foot addition to Sackett Building.

Students this year will "initiate" the Boucke Building which has been under construction since last year. The building contains classrooms, lecture rooms and offices of the College of Business Administration.

Another recent project of the University was the addition of a small greenhouse behind Plant Industries Building.

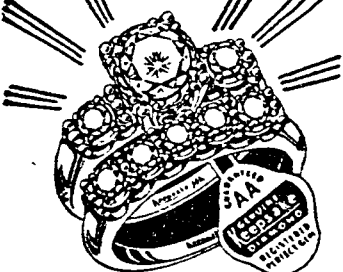
