

# Political Parties to Hold Soph, Frosh Nominations

Campus and Lion parties will hold preliminary nominations for candidates for sophomore and freshman class officers at clique meetings at 7 p.m. tomorrow.

Campus will meet in 121 Sparks, and Lion in 10 Sparks.

Nominations will be opened for candidates for president, vice president and secretary-treasurer of each class. Final

nominations and elections of candidates will be held at next week's meetings.

Tomorrow night will be the last time students may register for party membership. Those who have already registered may pick up their party cards by presenting matriculation cards at the door. Party members will be required to present both their party cards and matriculation cards for admission to the meetings.

Students who register tomorrow night may pick up party cards at next week's meeting. Both clique chairmen urged students who have not already registered to do so tomorrow so they may attend the final nominations meeting and vote for candidates.

The steering committee of Campus party will meet at 2 p.m. tomorrow in the Hetzel Union Building.

Lion's publicity committee will

meet at 1 p.m. tomorrow in 203 Willard. The steering committee will meet at 2 p.m. in the same room.

Elections Committee will meet at 6:15 p.m. tomorrow in 10 Sparks to set up committees to study the rotation system, the penalization clause of the Elections Code and clique finances. A publicity committee for fall elections to be held Nov. 13 and 14 also will be set up.
