• Every department wishing to start an honors program shall FOR GOOD RESUL1S submit a tentative program to the USE COLLEGIAN CLASSIFIEDS honors committee on or before March 1. Accepted programs will be begun in September 1958.

• The words "with Honors," "with High Honors" or "with Highest Honors" (in the major subject) shall be included on the diploma of each student graduating with departmental honors.

• A student must have a 3.0 All-University average at the end of the sophomore or junior year in order to be eligible for honors work. An average of 3.0 in all non-major subjects and a higher average in the major subject must be maintained by all students in the honors program.
