Genetics Professor Receives Grant

Dr. Donald F. Mitchell, assistant professor of genetics, has been granted \$4686 from the United States Department of Health, Education and Welfare to continue his studies of the effects of radiation on heredity.

Mitchell began research in 1955 under a United States Public Health Service grant. He is trying to determine how radiation affects the inheritance and expression of quantitative characters such as growth rate, body size, fertility, fecundity and sex ratio.

Last year, both were placed on office probation along with a third student after they returned to the residence halls with two six-packs of beer.



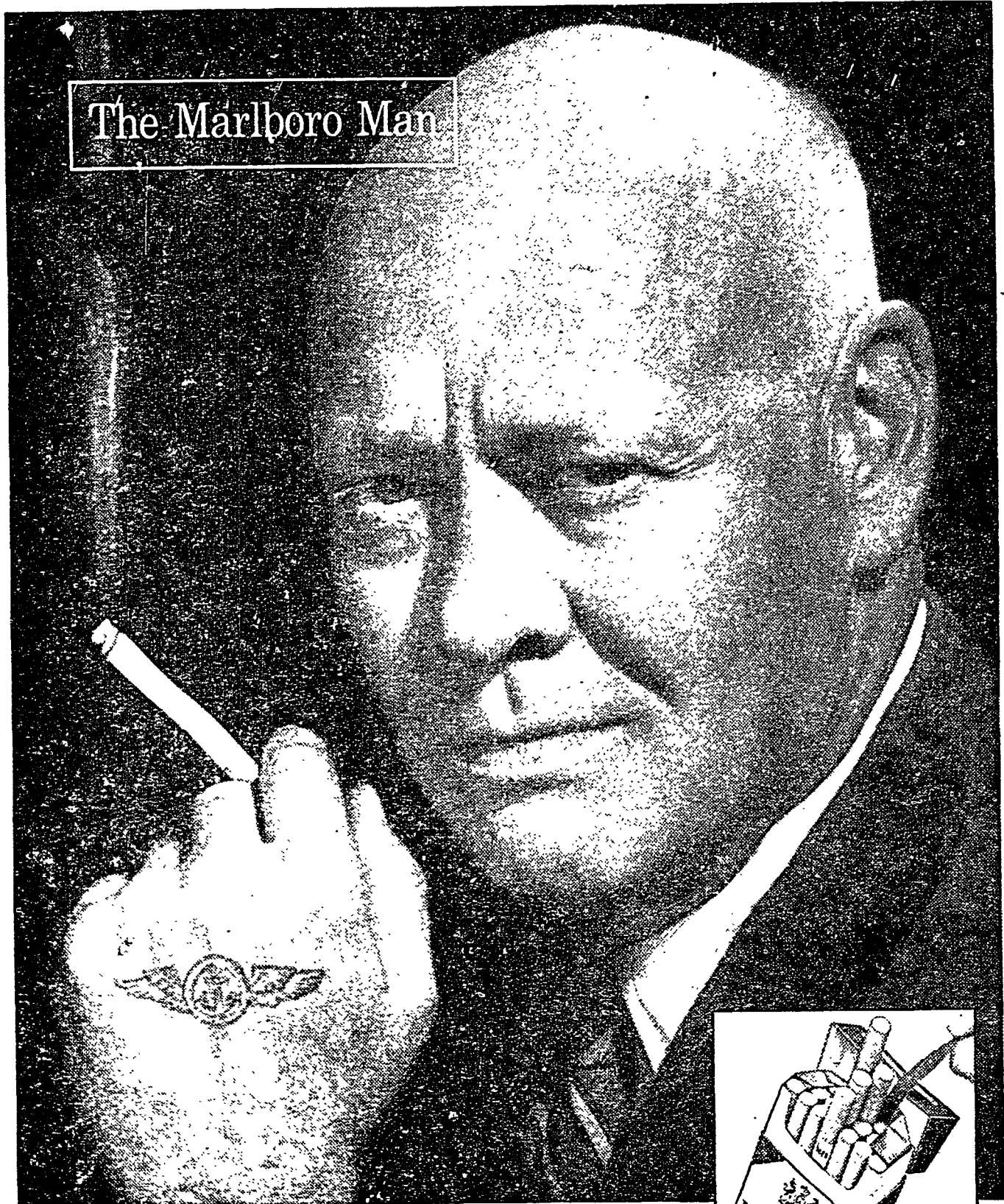
