Sabean has included 22 watercolors and four pieces of sculpture in the exhibition.

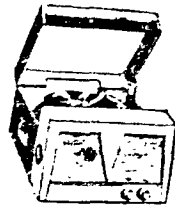
Gallodoro Will Perform With Blue Band
