# Meat Judges Judged Best at Meet

The University's meat judging team won top honors in judging lambs at the International Livestock Exposition in Chicago last week.

In other competition the University placed first in the Angus division with a pen of three Angus steers, second in the Hereford division with a pen of three Hereford steers and fourth in the Shorthorn division with a pen of three Shorthorn steers.

The livestock judging team ranked 14th in the livestock judging contest.

The University was 15th in overall competition among the 24 colleges and universities that took part in the exposition. The University of Wisconsin placed first

in overall competition. The exposition was held in conjunction with the International Livestock Show, which is held annually in Chicago.

Meat judging team members were Paul Slavik, junior in animal husbandry from State College; Jay Coble, junior in animal husbandry from Hershey; Glenn Klippenstein, junior in animal husbandry from Bryn Athyn; and Byron Hartley, junior in agricultural education from Fredericktown.

Glenn R. Kean, acting head of the department of Animal Husbandry, coached the team.

Members of the livestock judging team were Thomas Blose, senior in animal husbandry from Glen Campbell; Thomas McElwain, senior in animal husbandry

from Spring Church; Leslie Firth, senior in agricultural education from Sugargrove; Kermit Yearick, senior in animal husbandry from Mill Hall; and Tony Dobroski, senior in animal husbandry from Avonmore.

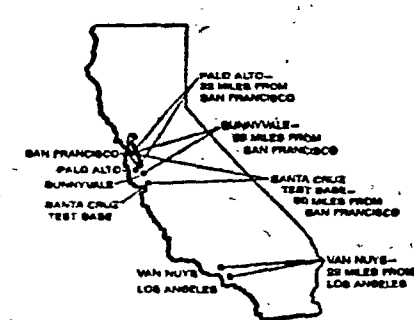
