

# Willard Stages West Halls Murder

A shot rang out and a shrill scream pierced the air as the tall blonde coed fell to the floor in Waring Lounge Wednesday night.

The incident didn't seem to phase the rest of the students in the lounge, however. They were there to hear a lecture by Dr. Mary L. Willard, who is a professor of chemistry and an expert in crime detection, and by this time they were used to the antimated demonstrations which punctuated Dr. Willard's lecture. The lecture, "Murder Under the Microscope," attended by approximately 50 students, was the second in the series of Fire-

side lectures sponsored by West Halls Council.

Dr. Willard vividly described criminal cases which she has helped solve in past years by methods of scientific crime detection.

She particularly went into detail in the description of the Roberts murder which occurred in 1952 in Wilkes-Barre. Dr. Willard explained that she was using this case for illustration because a large variety of tests had to be employed to establish who the murderer was.

"Any number of details may provide circumstantial evidence of great value in the solution of a case," Dr. Willard said.

She said, "These details must be found, and related to the case as soon as possible. Often a case

does not come before a judge and jury until months after the crime occurs, so the need for immediate action is necessary."

Several types of evidence which are of particular importance are the exact time of the crime, the type of weather, strands of hair, casts of footprints, blood types, fingernail scrapings, handwriting, type of bullets and fingerprints.

After Dr. Willard finished her lecture she fingerprinted the audience.




