

## Hillel Releases New Schedule For Semester

The Cultural Committee of the Hillel Foundation has announced the schedule of courses in the Hebrew and Yiddish language which will be given this semester.

Classes will meet once weekly and textbooks will be provided.

A course in beginner's Hebrew will be taught at 7 p.m. Wednesdays by Miss Alisa Kornfeld. This class will have its first meeting at 7 p.m. Feb. 19. A course in the Yiddish language and conversation will have its first session at 7 p.m. Monday, with Mrs. Anna Glasser as instructor.

Other courses in the Hebrew language include Intermediate Hebrew I, at 7 p.m. Mondays with Miss Kornfeld; Intermediate and Conversational Hebrew II at 7:15 p.m. Tuesdays with Miss Judith Wegner as instructor, and Advanced Hebrew at 7:30 p.m. Thursdays with Rabbi Benjamin M. Kahn as instructor.

Students and residents may attend whether or not they have pre-registered.

His widow, Mary Alice Zarger O'Brien survives.

Dr. H. B. McDonnell M.D., class of 1886, the University's oldest living graduate, died last Saturday in Riverdale, Md., at the age of 94.

A retired faculty member of the University of Maryland where he had served as head of the chemistry department and dean of applied science, he had been a resident of College Park, Md., for many years.

Survivors include a brother, Milton E. McDonnell, of Hollidaysburg, who was graduated from Penn State in 1893.

With Dr. McDonnell's death, the title of oldest living University graduate now belongs to James C. Mock, class of 1890, who lives in Detroit, Mich.
