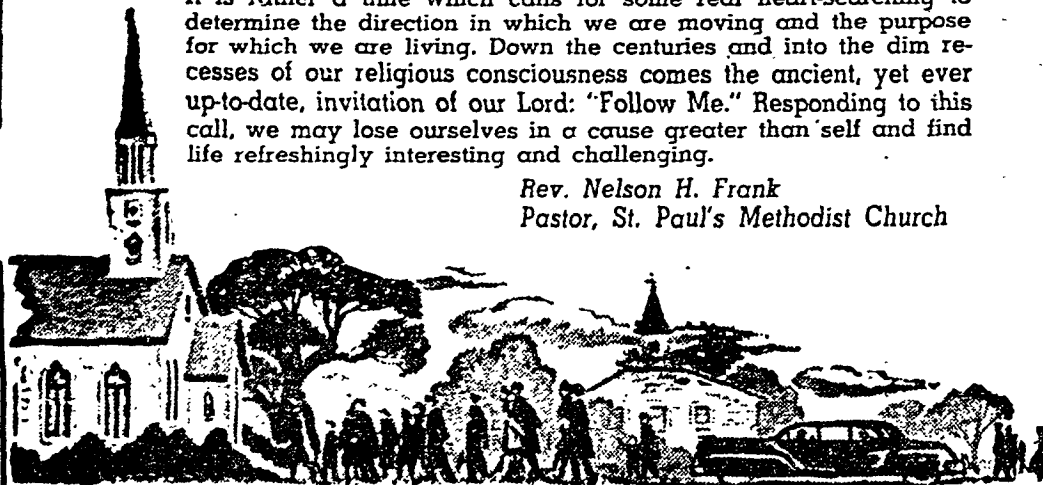


THE MEANING OF LENT
