International Geophysical Year.
Dr. Erwin R. Schmerling, assistant professor of electrical engineering in charge of the research, and his assistants work with sweep frequency recordings taken from radio communications infor-mation gathered at 170 stations throughout the world.

Films containing the data from the stations come in 1000-foot rolls, each representing a month's information. The data is analyzed by Schmerling and his colleagues and fed to the PENNSTAC digital computer. The mathematical computations required are so compli-cated that it would take an individual years to do some of themthat the computer does in minutes, Schmerling says.
