1,000 Rooms Added To Hike Acapulco Lure

ACAPULCO—About 1000 hotel rooms are being added in 1958 to facilities of this Pacific resort, according to Oscar Caligaris, president of the Acapulco Hotel Ass'n. This growth of rooms to 9000 by the end of 1958.

Bargains for the economy-minded traveler are one result of this steady expansion. Several small hotels offer food and lodging for \$5 to \$7 U.S. total a day for two persons in a double room, according to Mr. Caligaris. Room-in houses provide a single room with meals at rates varying from \$1.60 to \$3.30 U.S. a day per person.

About 18 hotels are in the deluxe and first class categories, with prices on the deluxe ranging upwards from \$12 a day per person American plan and from \$6.40 up for the first class establishments. Private homes may be rented from \$12 to \$80 a day.

Another result of the mushrooming hotel facilities is a trend toward the European plan. Some of the newer hotels have the Continental plan with hotel room and a complete breakfast.

(Continued from first page) tion depending on class of service used. The reduction per person in First Class is \$150 one-way or \$300 round trip; in Tourist Class \$130 one-way, \$200 round trip; in Economy Class \$100 one-way, \$150 round trip.

The family must travel as a single unit from the point of origin to the point of destination, or to the first point of call beyond the trans-Atlantic crossing.

Thus a family of four traveling Economy Class New York to London and return would pay \$453.60 for the head of the family plus \$303.60 for each of the other 3 eligible members. Averaging the trans-Atlantic cost each person would pay a round trip fare of only \$341.10.

In past years late Fall or Winter travel to Europe fell off very considerably from the summer peak. The extra savings afforded by the combination of Economy fare and off-season Family fare is now responsible for a marked increase in travel during the Fall, Winter and early Spring.

(Continued from first page) designed for cruising. The sister ships are completely air-conditioned and equipped with stabilizers.

Canadian Pacific's Empress of England is scheduled for 4 cruises of 14 and 19 days to the West Indies and South America. Both The Norwegian American Line and The Swedish American Line offer a wide variety of Caribbean ports in their Fall and Winter cruise schedules. The air conditioned Olympia of The Greek Line is scheduled for three West Indies and South American cruises in December and January.

The nicely equipped Alcoa ships carrying a limited number of passengers maintain weekly service between New Orleans and the Caribbean. The ever popular Ocean Monarch and Queen of Bermuda of the Furness Line will maintain a full schedule of weekly sailings to Bermuda. The Nassau of the Nassau Inces Line similarly plies between New York and Nassau weekly.

Airlines Have 4 Different World Tours

The combined globe-girdling routes of TWA and Northwest Airlines now are employed in four different two-month around-the-world itineraries prepared by American Express, Thomas Cook and Penn State Travel. Travelers are offered a choice of first class, tourist or economy accommodations, with tours priced from \$3119 to \$3753, and shorter 35-day trips from \$2348 to \$2948.

Tourists may elect either westbound or eastbound departures. Westbound the tour covers Japan, the Philippines, Thailand, Ceylon, India, Egypt, Lebanon, Syria, Jordan, Greece. Entering Europe the tourist has two weeks in Rome, Paris and London before the trans-Atlantic flight to New York.

Tourists who prefer to auto through Europe will be attracted to Autourist's Fly 'n Drive Plan. Typical trip includes tourist passage via Icelandic Airlines to Copenhagen with return via Hamburg plus rental of a Volkswagen deluxe sedan for 21 days at a cost of \$496.50. Price covers insurance, maintenance and repair of car; touring documents, individualized itineraries, road maps, and hotel reservation service. Penn State Travel represents Autourist.

Daily Expenses Listed for Italy

Daily expenses for foreign visitors to Italy have been estimated at \$17.38 for first class tourists. This includes \$6.60 for lodging, \$7.61 for food, \$1.30 for local transportation and \$1.87 to cover miscellaneous expenses.

For budget travelers, the total outlay per day is estimated at \$11.38. This figure allows \$3.24 for lodgings, \$5.28 for food, \$1.30 for local transportation and \$1.55 for miscellaneous expenses.
