

# Coeds Say Clagett Hits Class of '62

Six coeds have signed an affidavit that Donald Clagett, University party candidate for sophomore class president, referred to freshmen as "rowdy."

Clagett reportedly made the statement Wednesday night while campaigning in Hoyt Hall. Allegedly he was discussing the Campus party plank on the student seating arrangement in the new football stadium, and said he would not blame the juniors and seniors on All-University Cabinet for opposing a general student section because they would not like to sit with a bunch of "rowdy" freshmen.

Clagett said a coed in Hoyt asked him if upperclassmen and seniors would like to sit with rowdy freshmen. He said he replied that he didn't think upperclassmen would sit with what she considered to be rowdy freshmen.

Howard Byers, University party clique chairman, said Clagett had paraphrased the coed's statement rather than initiated the term. Byers said that from what he had gathered from Clagett's speech, the candidate meant that freshmen were very exuberant, displaying a lot of school spirit.

James Elliott, Campus party clique chairman, said, "I think that any person aspiring for such an important seat as All-University Cabinet is quite irresponsible if he would make such a remark as 'rowdy freshmen'."
