

Tickets for Concert To Be Distributed

Distribution of student tickets for the Elizabeth Schwarzkopf Concert, which is scheduled for 8 p.m. Wednesday in Schwab Auditorium, will begin at 1 p.m. Sunday.

Students may obtain tickets by presenting matriculation cards at the Hetzel Union desk. Distribution will continue through Wednesday or until all tickets have been given out. The sale of tickets to non-students will begin at 9 a.m. Monday and continue through Wednesday. Tickets are \$1.25.

Members of the Artist Series Committee have asked students not to leave concerts early. They said hours for coeds are extended for special University events to allow students to remain for the entire program and have enough time to return to the residence halls.

Elizabeth Schwarzkopf is a soprano whose operatic performances and interpretations of German lieder have brought her the acclaim of critics throughout the world. Her first American concert in 1953 made her one of the singers most sought after by American conductors and concert sponsors. Until that time she was known

to American audiences primarily through her recordings. Miss Schwarzkopf holds many awards for her contribution to music, among them the Lilli Lehmann Medal and the Orfeo d'Oro. In 1956, the Philharmonia Chorus of London set up a scholarship in her name which provides one year of free tuition to an outstanding woman singer and private instruction from Miss Schwarzkopf herself.

In private life, Miss Schwarzkopf is the wife of Walter Legge, the recording director of EMI (Electric and Musical Industries), the company that issues its records in America under the "Angel" label. Legge is also the founder and director of the famed Philharmonia Orchestra and Philharmonia Chorus, both of London.

Miss Schwarzkopf's appearance here is the seventh in the present Artist Series program.

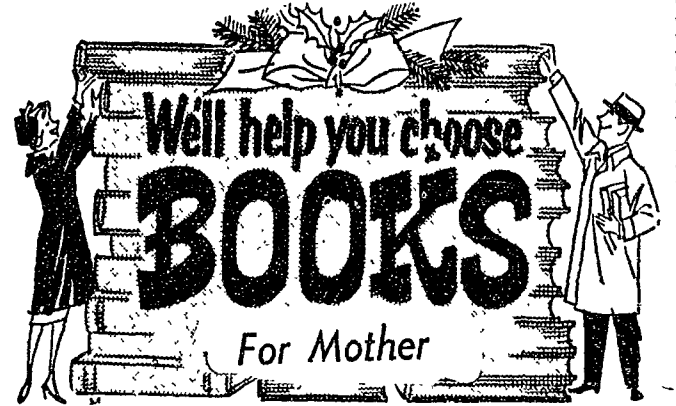
