Karhan Will Conduct Winter Symphony

The Annual Winter Concert will be presented by the University Symphony Orchestra under the baton of Theodore Karhan at 3 p.m. tomorrow in Schwab Auditorium.

Karhan, associate professor of music and music education, will conduct the orchestra in a varied program containing the works of Gerore Fredrick, Handel, Franz Schubert, Isaac Albeniz and Jaromir Weinberger.

The first selection of the 50-piece orchestra will be Handel's suite from "The Music for the Royal Fireworks."

Handel was commissioned to write this work as accompaniment to a display of fireworks celebrating the end of the War of the Austrian Succession. It is a composition containing all the melodic and rhythmic invention that typifies the music of Handel.

The second number to be presented will be "Symphony No. 5 in B-flat Major" by Franz Schubert. In this piece the clarinets, trumpets and tympany are not used. Schubert wrote this symphony for a small group of friends who often played at his home.

"Serenade Espagnole" by Isaac Albeniz will be the third selection. This is an excerpt from a suite of Spanish dances which

has occasionally been used as a short ballet.

The final number in the concert will be "Polka and Fugue" from Jaromir Weinberger's opera "Shvanda." The opera was written while Weinberger was professor of composition at the Ithaca Conservatory of Music.

Chapel Sermon To Be Given By Williams

The Rev. Preston N. Williams will speak on "Christ, the Wisdom of God" at the University Chapel service of worship at 10:55 a.m. tomorrow in Schwab Auditorium.

Williams is an assistant University chaplain.

Charles E. Minneman, assistant University chaplain, will be the liturgist for the services.

George E. Ceiga, University organist, will play the following compositions by Johann Sebastian Bach: as prelude, "Wie Schon Leuchtet der Morgenstern"; as offertory, "Das Alte Jahr Vergangen Ist"; as postlude, "Fugue in G Major."

The Chapel Choir, under the direction of Willa Taylor, will sing as the choral introt, "Arise and Shine in Splendor," by Heinrich Isaak and as the anthem, "Come and Thank Him" from Johann Sebastian Bach's "The Christmas Oratorio."

Williams is a graduate of the Yale University Divinity School. He joined the staff of the Office of the University Chaplain in 1956.

He is the chairman of the Committee on Interreligious Affairs which along with the School of the Arts, co-sponsored the recent exhibition in the Hetzel Union Building, "God and Man in Art."

The Committee is currently making plans for the annual Brotherhood Banquet on Feb. 12.

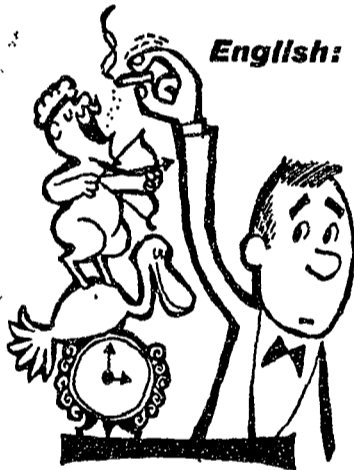

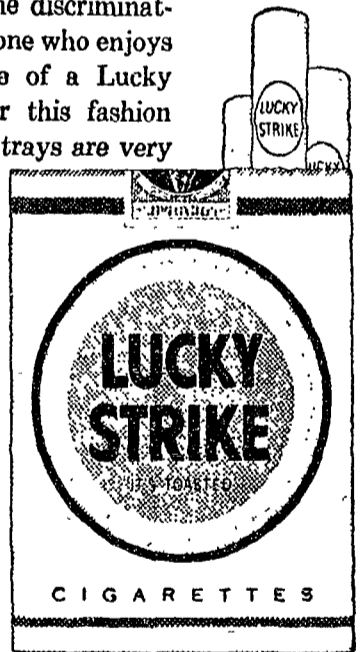
English: WEIRDLY SHAPED ASH TRAY

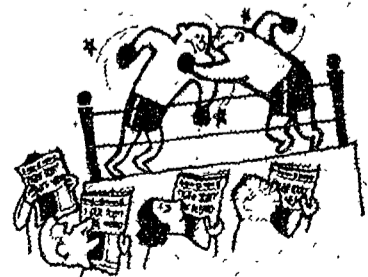
