Students who come here with minor ailments are examined by a doctor treatment. Those with more ser-ious illnesses are admitted to the University Hospital.

The hospital is open 24 hours a day during all school sessions except Thanksgiving, Christmas and Spring Recesses. During the hours when the dispensary is closed, emergency cases are treated in the hospital.

Students who require emergency treatment should report to the nurse at the main desk in the hospital. In the event of a serious case, the nurse will contact a doctor who is on call at all times.

The health center is capable of handling almost all emergencies with the exception of those re-quiring general surgery. Surgical cases are sent to the Centre County Hospital in Bellefonte.

In addition to the usual doctors and nuises, the health center has a dental department located on the second floor. This department is equipped for all types of dental work. Students may take advant-age of this service for emergency
