Fulbright Grant Given To Wright for Research

400 Acres Razed By 6-Hour Fire

A forest fire in the Rothrock District, west of State College, near the borough dump, destroyed more than 400 acres Sunday, before being brought under control at 8 p.m. that evening.

Reported at 2:15 p.m. by the Little Flat Tower, the blaze was battled by more than 100 men before it was controlled six hours later. Firefighters remained on the scene until 1 a.m. when a light rain dampened the area.

It is believed the fire started on the first ridge north of the borough dump. The exact cause of the fire has not been determined, although youngsters were reported in the area at the time.

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




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
