

Indie Men Top Greek Average Last Semester

Upperclass independent men's all-university averages were a little above fraternity men's averages for the fall semester.

According to a report made by the Association of Independent Men, upperclass independents had an average of 2.38 while that of all fraternity men was 2.32.

If freshmen are included, independent averages come to 2.23. However, the report said it would not be valid to include freshman averages since all fraternity men are upperclassmen.

Edward Frymoyer, AIM president, attributed the higher averages to less independent social activities and better study conditions in independent living quarters.

Broken down by class, the averages were: freshman men, 2.00; sophomore independent men, 2.20 and sophomore fraternity men, 2.12; junior independent men, 2.38 and junior fraternity men, 2.28; senior independent men, 2.64 and senior fraternity men, 2.55.

Averages for all men came to 2.35. For all sophomore men, they were 2.18, junior men 2.31 and senior men 2.61.

Cabinet Socials Inform Students

Students will have the opportunity to learn more about student government by attending coffee hours sponsored by All-University Cabinet.

The coffee hours are being held from 3 to 5 p.m. every Tuesday in 203 Helzel Union.
