

# Changes Will Greet Returning Students

Many changes in campus life will greet returning students in the fall as a result of the University expansion program.

Such things as the opening of the four new men's residence halls, the new telephone system, new campus walks and construction projects nearing completion will add to the ever-changing campus scene.

The new residence halls will present new names of buildings to remember.

There will be Runkle, Leete, Holmes, Beam and Warnock Halls comprising what will be known as the North Dorms.

Runkle is located on Shortridge Road and the other residence halls are along Park Avenue.

Besides names, there will be telephone numbers to remember one for each individual on campus. Each number will begin with UNiversity 5 followed by four digits. Calls will be able to be made into the residence halls any time of the day or night.

All campus offices will also have individual numbers instead of an extension number. The use of these direct lines will eliminate the necessity of a University switchboard.

The opening of the North Halls made this change necessary because the present

switchboards were overcrowded. The new equipment will go into effect Aug. 16. The new telephone building will also house the staff of the campus patrol, presently located in Spruce Cottage.

The opening of the new residence halls will cause other changes. Many new campus walks are already being constructed and others resurfaced to accommodate the increase of pedestrian traffic.

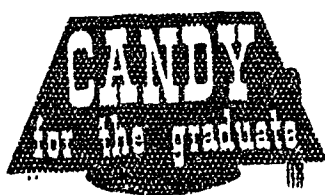

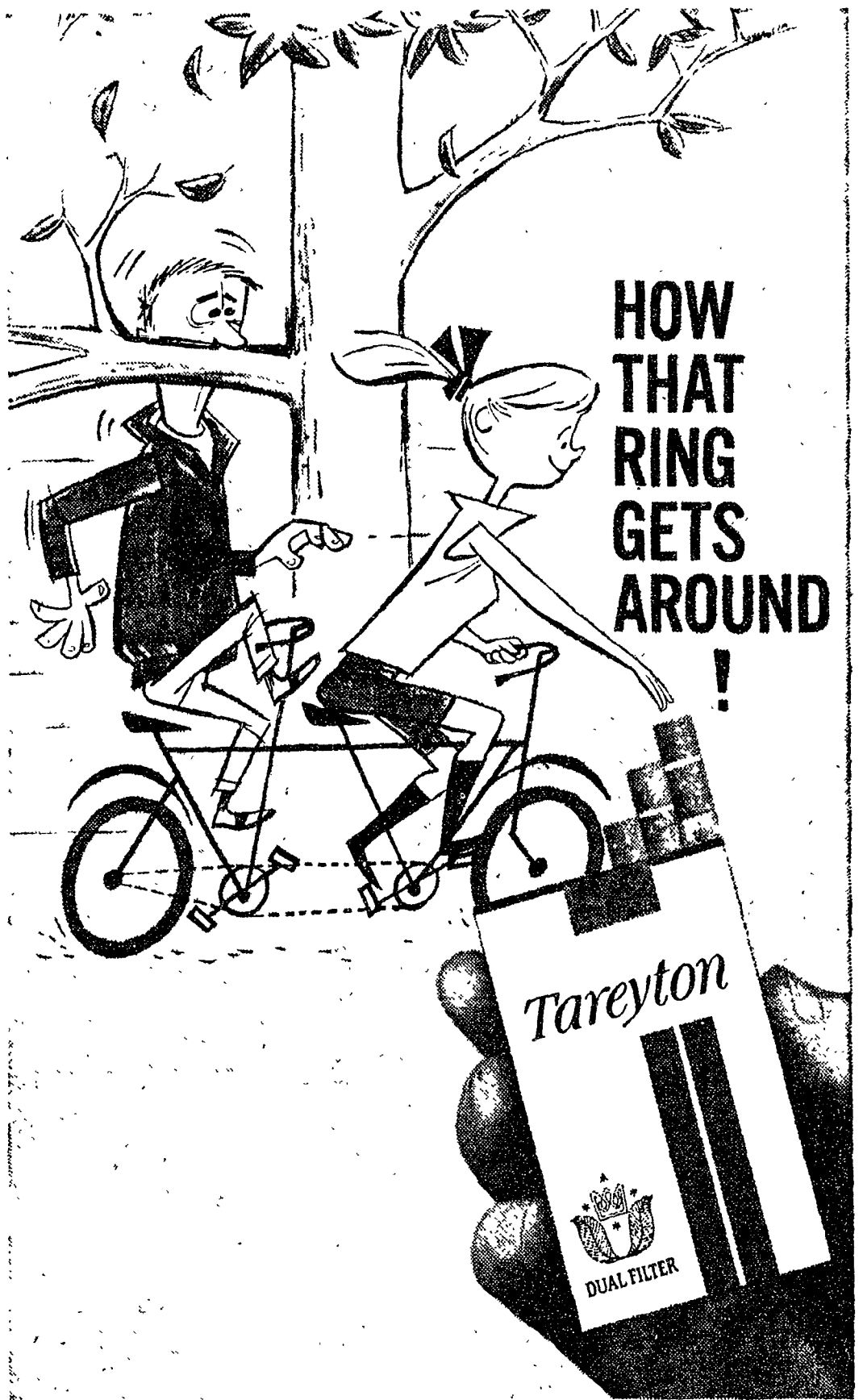

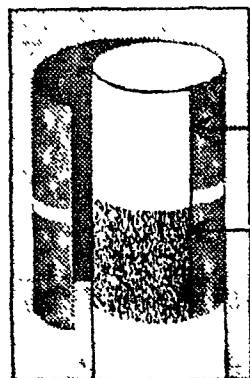
