Hacker Named Visiting Prof In History

Dr. Louis M. Hacker, professor of economic history at Columbia University, has been named a visiting professor of history, effective Sept. 1.

Hacker will serve for a semester and is the third visiting professor of history at the University. Other guest professors have been Herbert Heaton, University of Minnesota, and Thomas D. Clark, University of Kentucky.

He received his bachelor and masters degree from Columbia University and was also granted a master of arts degree Oxford University in 1948 and a honorary doctor of laws degree by the University of Hawaii in 1953.

Since 1935 Hacker has been a member of the economics department at Columbia and has been a full professor since 1948. He was director and dean of the School of General Studies at Columbia between 1949 and 1958.

Ridenour Will Retire As Professor Emeritus

Chauncey O. Ridenour, who has served on the faculty at the University for 39 years, will retire July 1 as professor emeritus of English literature.

Ridenour began his college teaching career as an instructor in English at the University in 1920. In 1925 he was made assistant professor of English literature, in 1933 an associate professor, and in 1943 professor of English literature.

George E. Ceiga, University organist, will play "Ein feste Burg ist unser Gott" by Johann Pachelbel; "Herr Christ, der einig Gottes Sohn" by Johann Walther, and "Fugue in E minor," by Johann Sebastian Bach.

The Chapel Choir, under the direction of Mrs. Willa Taylor, will sing the morning anthem.

"This I Believe: A Chemist Speaks" is the topic of a speech by Louis Legory, associate professor of chemistry. He will speak to the University Christian Association undergraduate fellowship at 7 p.m. Sunday in the Eisenhower Chapel.

The graduate group of the University Christian Association also will meet at 5 p.m. Sunday at the Presbyterian Student Center, 132 W. Beaver Ave., and then go to an area park for a picnic and discussion of the book, "Handbook of Christian Theology."

Hagen to Retire July 4 After 28 Years' Service

Meyer to Make Trip To Europe for Army

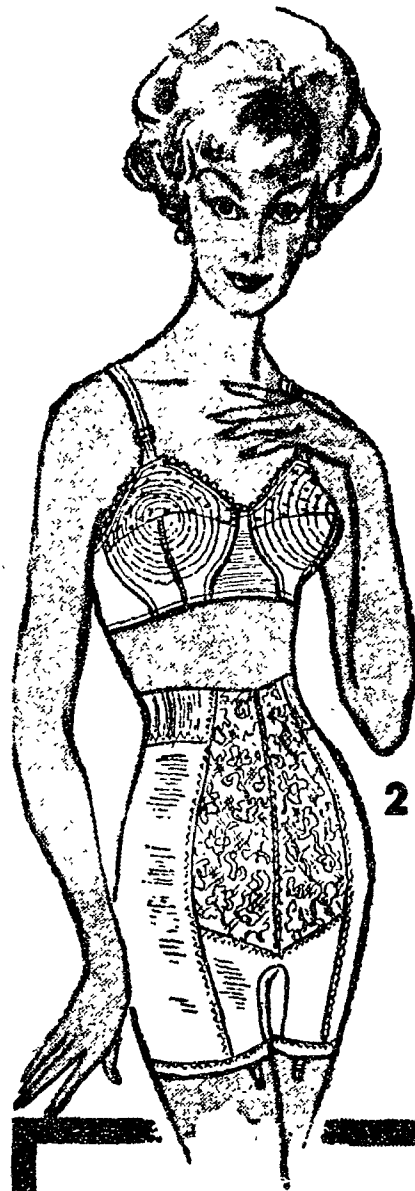
