

Chaplain to Speak At Sunday Services

Dr. Luther H. Harshbarger, University Chaplain and Coordinator of Religious Affairs, will speak at the University Chapel service at 9 a.m. Sunday in the Helen Eakin Eisenhower Chapel.

"The Enemy of Holidays" will be the sermon theme.

George E. Ceiga, University organist, will play as prelude "Lob den Herren, den 'Machtigen Konig der Ehren" by Walther. The offertory will be "Adagio from Concerto 11" by Bach. The "Fugue in B major" by Bach will be the postlude.

The choir, composed of summer session students and friends of the University Chapel, under the direction of Willa Taylor, will sing the morning anthem.

This will be Dr. Harshbarger's last sermon before leaving for a sabbatical year at Cambridge University.

"Religion and Public Education" is the topic for a series of two panel discussions planned by the University Christian Association to be held at 8 p.m. Monday and Wednesday in the Chapel lounge.

"Religion in the Public Schools: Fact and Fancy" is the title of the Monday evening panel. Dr. Donald McGarey, professor of education, will be the moderator of the panel. Panel members will be Dr. Abram VanderMeer, associate dean of the College of Education, Dr. Franklin Miller, professor of education, and Senator Jo Hays, Clearfield and Centre counties.

"Education and the Development of Student Values" is the topic for Wednesday evening. John Rackley, dean of the College of Education, will be the chairman of the panel. Dr. Francis Whaley, associate professor of psychology, Dr. Neal Riemer, associate professor of political science, and Rustum Roy, professor of geochemistry, will be the panel members.

The panel discussions are open to students and faculty members.

Gardening Course To Begin Monday

Homeowners and nurserymen will begin study Monday as part of the 5th annual Improving the Home Grounds course.

Dr. F. C. Snyder, chairman of the program, said that emphasis will be placed on the selection, use and maintenance of plant materials.

Each year a different topic is chosen which will aid nurserymen and homeowners in the care of yards and gardens.

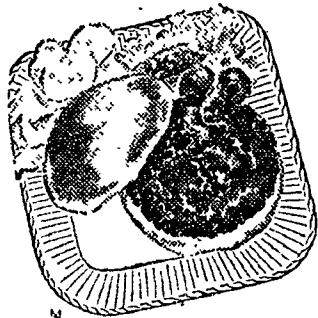
Calendar Deadline Set

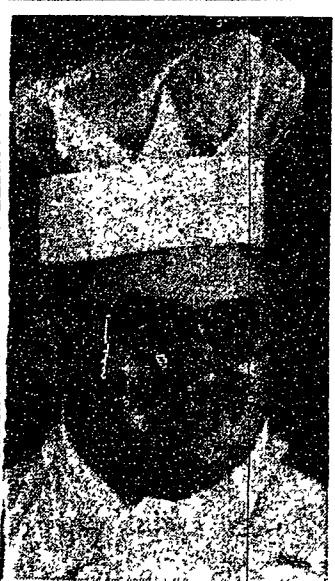

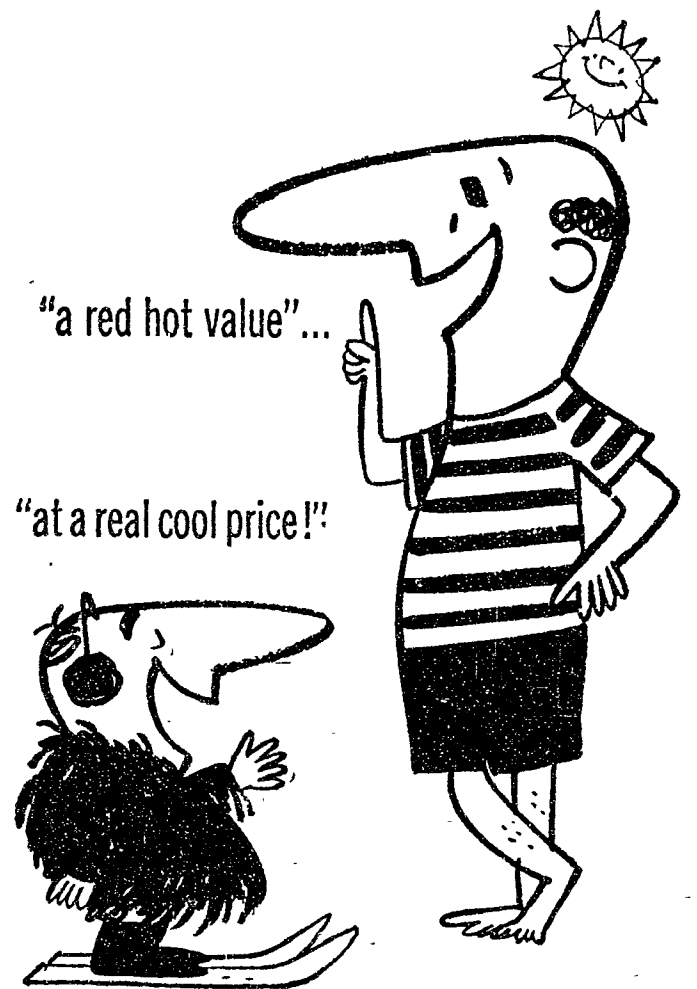
