# Lincoln Exhibit Displayed at Patee Library

An exhibit commemorating the sesqui-centennial of the birth of President Abraham Lincoln is now on view at the Patee Library.

All Lincolniana found in the University's collection of historical documents is on display.

A highlight of the display is an original Lincoln letter dated June 4, 1860, which he wrote to the Washington Agricultural Literary Society expressing his thanks to the society for making him an honorary member.

Another interesting item is a picture of Lincoln taken during the 1860 Presidential campaign which was given to the University by Fred Lewis Pattee.

The Civil War President served as the central figure in Henry Varnum Poor's famous Land Grant frescoes painted in the lobby of Old Main, University administration building. Pictures and material concerning the frescoes are included in the exhibit.


