Lions Ranked 11th By Grid Magazine

Penn State ranks as America's 11th-best football team for 1959.

So says the latest edition of Street and Smith's Football Yearbook—slated to hit the newsstands in late July.

One of the more popular of the annual pre-season grid publications, Street and Smith names Penn State and Army as Eastern representatives among the "Nation's Top Dozen" for 1959. The Cadets are tabbed to finish fourth, behind top-ranked Mississippi, Northwestern, and North Carolina.

Others in the top 12 are Auburn, Oklahoma, Southern California, S.M.U., Purdue, L.S.U., and Notre Dame.

In picking the Nittany Lions as a contender for national ranking, the magazine says: "Penn State, with Richie Lucas, rated by coach Rip Engle as the best

all-around back in the country, directing a team listing seven starters from last season, enters the campaign as a dark horse for Eastern and National honors."

The publication lists Lucas as one of its six quarterback candidates for All-American consideration. The others are Don Meredith, S.M.U., Dick Thornton, North western, Dale Hackbart, Wisconsin, George Izo, Notre Dame, and Joe Caldwell, Army.

Penn State will seek its 21st consecutive winning football season this fall. The Nittany Lions last lost more grid games than they won in 1938, when the record was 3-4-1.

Since jumping off on their winning streak in 1939, the Lions have recorded 120 triumphs, 48 defeats, and 8 ties. Included in that record was a trip to the Cotton Bowl following a 9-1 campaign in 1947.

Coach Rip Engle has been at the helm for the last nine winning campaigns.


