 val of the Executive Committee of the Board of Trustees at a weekend meeting and contracts totaling nearly \$7 million will be awarded to low bidders.

The buildings, which will be ready for occupancy by Fall, 1961, will be located on the former turf grass plots north of the intersection of Curtin Rd. and Entrance Rd.

Three identical buildings of eight floors, one unit of five floors, and a dining hall building of two floors are included in the project on which work will begin this summer.
