250 to Participate In ATO Congress

Telephone Open House To Be Held

University students, now able to dial directly to on-campus numbers, will be able to see the new automatic dial connection system when members of the Bell Telephone Co. host an open house Sunday at the new Telephone Building.

From 2 to 5 p.m., employees and University guides will meet visitors and conduct them in small groups through the building, and will point out such features as the switchboard in operation, information centers and the vault where the main circuits enter the new building.

The new system, first of its kind in Pennsylvania and the fourth of its kind in the nation, went into operation Sunday morning, climaxing several years of planning and months of actual construction of the building and equipment.

The purpose of the new system, which links more than 3200 telephones in administrative offices and residence halls, is to speed calls from the nearby area as well as calls dialed by long distance operators to the proper telephone on the campus.
