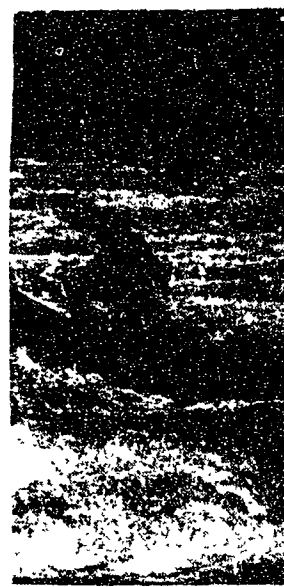
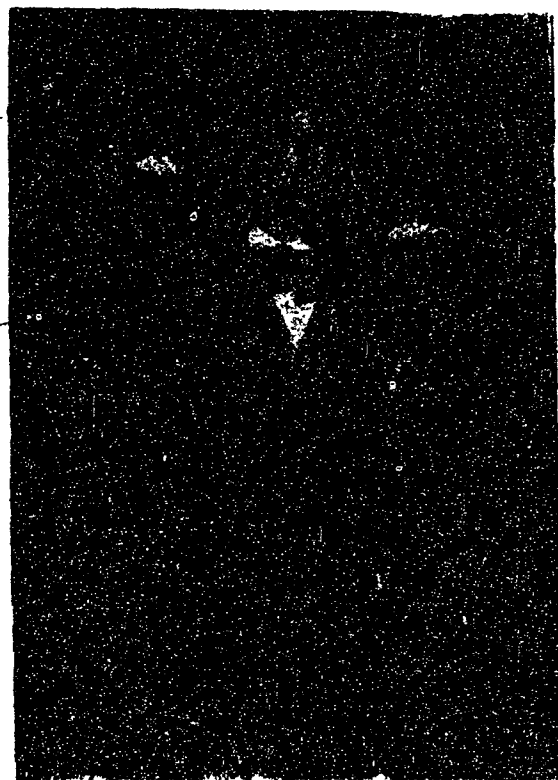


PENN STATE OUTING CLUB
