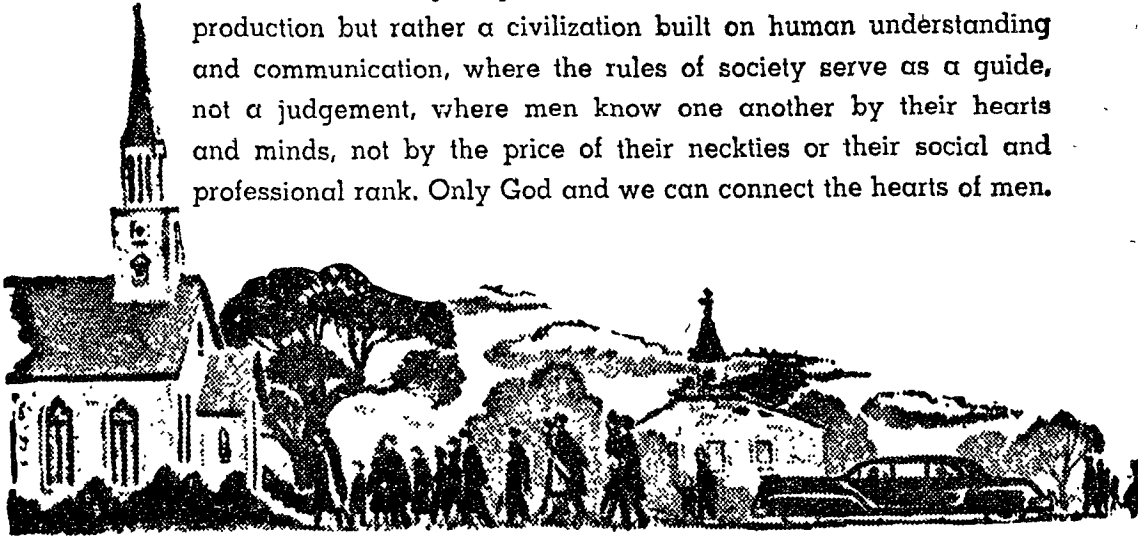


COME TO CHURCH
