

Fighter Dies After Bout With Bantam Champion

GUADALAJARA, Mexico (AP)—Walt Ingram, 24, a bantam-weight fighter out of Houston, died yesterday of injuries received in a nontitle bout Saturday with World Champion Jose Becerra of Mexico. An attending physician attributed the death to a heart attack following respiratory interruption.

Ingram, born in Weirton, W. Va., had undergone a 2½ hour operation Saturday night after two hospitals reportedly refused to admit him because they lacked proper facilities.
