

Space Vehicle Sighted by Student

The mysterious sparkling object sighted in the sky at 5:45 last night is believed to have been a military test vehicle fired from Wallops Island, Virginia.

Charles Boster, senior in agriculture economics and rural sociology from Harrisburg, said he and several companions sighted the object moving in a southeasterly direction.

He said the object was "very bright in comparison to the few visible stars," and it seemed to give off a revolving sensation.

The United Press International said last night that scientists from Wallops Island fired a test vehicle carrying an inflatable balloon some 200 miles over the Atlantic Ocean.
