

Mardi Gras Festivities To Begin at 8 Tonight

Mardi Gras, the all-women's carnival offering skits, and skill and fun games will begin at 8 tonight in Recreation Hall.

Before the carnival begins, a motocade of the 21 king candidates will tour the campus. The motocade will begin at 6:30 p.m. at the Entrance Road.

The king will then pass by Nittany, Simmons and McElwain Halls, go up Shortridge Rd. and Park Ave. to the North Halls; pass the Library and proceed up Curtin Rd. to the West Halls and arrive at Rec Hall for the start of Mardi Gras.
