The high flying Owls of Temple University will roost in University Park tomorrow morning in an attempt to make the Penn State booters their eighth straight victim of the 1959 campaign.
The Owl booters have racked up seven wins thus far and have been very impressive in doing so.
Coach Pete Leaness's forces have completely humbled Bucknell 7-0, Hosfstra, 11-0, La Salle, 4-0 $5-0$. The only two teams that hav scored on the Owls are Haverford and Wagner.
