This means that no clerical employe can even begin to work toward a degree in art; because virtually all art courses, athough they are with-in the six-credit limit, meet for six to nine hours a week and seldom meet on Saturdays. A five credit course in chemis-

iry is also out of the question.
I do not wish to imply that the clerical employe should be permitted to take more hours from her legiti-mate work in order to study. The work for which one is hired definitely should come before the personal pursuit of higher education. However, I do contend that the present regulations governing the educational privileges of University employes are too restrictive for proper development of the individual in the democracy that the University purports to stand for.

A little flexibility in these provisions would enable many people, who otherwise cannot afford to stop work and become full-time students, to attain a degree in their chosen fields.
